Another u-pick season is approaching and this will be our thirty second, how time flies! We had another mild winter in Southwest Michigan and a cold, wet spring. In early May we had two nights with temperatures dipping into the mid twenties, there was wide spread damage in all fruit crops. However, thanks to an extra heavy bud set we have a very good supply of peaches and apples.

- Call Ahead** Always call ahead to check weather & picking conditions, peaches and berries should not be picked when they are wet.
- Dress properly** Layered shirts, sunscreen, insect repellent, hats and closed-toed flat shoes.
- Bring Containers** Save money by bringing your own containers. Small shallow boxes or ½ bushel baskets transport fruit best.
