It is almost u-pick season, our first red raspberry patch looks very healthy and is starting to flower. Our first blueberry patch is in full bloom and looks like it will be a beautiful crop. That is a huge sweet berry called Duke. There will be lots of peaches this year. We have a relatively new peach called Glenglo. This early variety is a free stone peach that is extra sweet and flavorful, you don't want to miss this one! Glenglo should be available the last week of July. Our Red Haven peaches should be ready the first week of August.

It looks like we will have a nice crop of all apple varieties, Honey Crisp should be ready to pick early September. Below is our 2017 picking schedule. All time frames are an estimate, for up to date picking information please call (269) 561-5126.

- Call Ahead** Always call ahead to check weather & picking conditions, peaches and berries should not be picked when they are wet.
- Dress properly** Layered shirts, sunscreen, insect repellent, hats and closed-toed flat shoes.
- Bring Containers** Save money by bringing your own containers. Small shallow boxes or ½ bushel baskets transport fruit best.
